Incentives Program (EQIP)

The Environmental Quality Incentives Program helps farmers promote agricultural production while sustaining environmental quality. EQIP offers financial and technical help to assist farmers to construct or begin using conservation practices on farmland.

Organic

EQIP Organic Initiative

The Organic Initiative offers financial and technical assistance to help producers who are transitioning to organic farming and those that are currently certified organic producers. Assistance is for conservation practices related to organic production.

High Tunnels (Tseb vov ntaub yas)

EQIP High Tunnels or Hoop Houses



Through EQIP, NRCS can help pay the costs for the construction of High Tunnels.

NRCS muaj nyiaj los ntawm EQIP pab rau cov pejxeem ua liaj ua teb yuav ib lub tsev vov ntaub yas kom tau cog tej qoobloo mus rau lub caij no.

High tunnels, or “Hoop Houses” extend the growing season and may help reduce the need for pesticides, keep vital nutrients in the soil, increase yields, and provide other benefits to growers. High tunnels provide steady incomes to farmers - a significant advantage to owners of small farms, limited-resource farmers and organic producers.

NRCS will fund one high tunnel per farm. High tunnels can be as large as 5 percent of 1 acre or 2178 sq. ft. To sign up or learn more about EQIP assistance for high tunnel projects, contact your local NRCS office.

Funding (Nyia txiag Pab)

The 2008 Farm Bill has 10 percent of its funding set aside for socially disadvantaged and beginning farmers with cost-share rates up to 90 percent. There are special funds dedicated for organic and specialty crop practices as well.
