Robert Moeller is a dairy and grain farmer who signed on for two additional conservation practices with CSP this spring. He was planning to do some conservation work already, and saw CSP as a great opportunity to get compensated for his efforts.

“Our objective is always to be good stewards of the land, and CSP gives us an extra push in doing so,” says Robert. He currently practices minimum tillage on all of his cropland, and has had a nutrient management plan for the past four years.

Through CSP, Robert signed up to recycle all of the farm’s waste oil and begin tissue sampling of corn to gauge nitrogen use. “We hope to reduce the nitrogen needs of our corn crops,” he says, noting that this practice will apply to 350 acres of land.

According to Robert, the CSP sign up process is not as difficult as it may appear. He found out about the program only one day before sign-up closed, and he’s glad he rushed in to participate—his sign-up went quickly, and he’s happy with the program so far.
